In this guide, we will walk you through logging in and navigating the units and lessons in the digital student edition. Along the way, we'll point out features that will be helpful to you.











Program structure






Exploring a unit

Here's how to move around a unit:




From the top nav bar, select your grade level. Then select your unit.




Here's what you'll see on your screen as you work through a lesson.





Global navigation

You can find the Global Navigation menu in the top left corner of your screen. This menu includes many components and apps you'll want to use.





My Work: A customizable space to review your teacher's feedback and portfolio of work to further develop your skills.



Amplify Library: A digital library of more than 700 texts across reading levels of interest to middle-schoolers, including some in Spanish.



Quests: Multi-day experiential simulations in which students work together using evidence and ideas they have learned from their reading to solve a problem or experience a narrative.




Vocabulary app: Provides engaging games, repeated encounters with new words across multiple contexts, and an interactive stats page that helps them track their own progress.
