In this guide, we will walk you through logging in and navigating the units and lessons in the digital student edition. Along the way, we'll point out features that will be helpful to you.

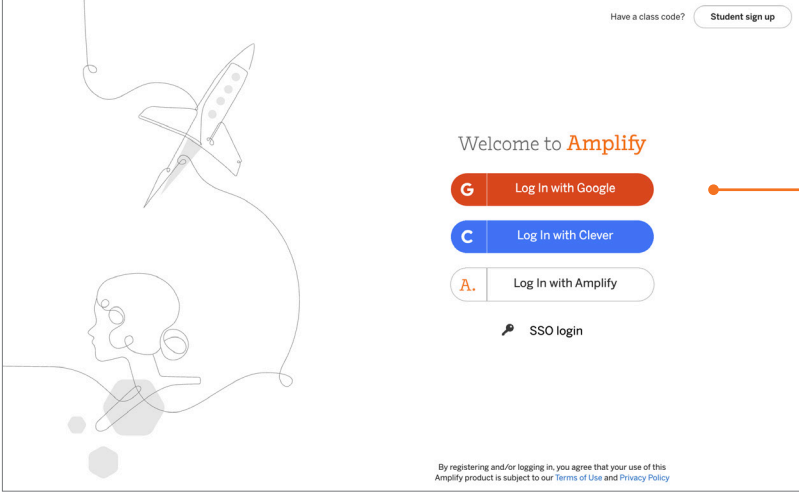


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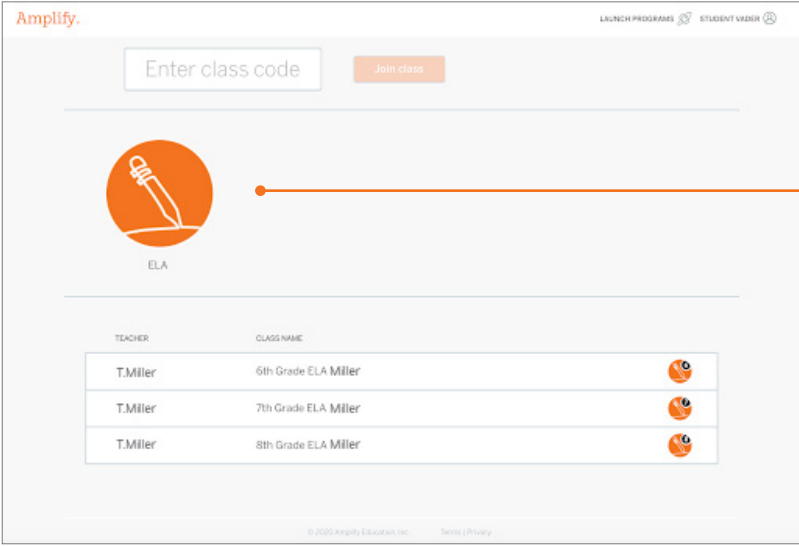
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Logging in



- 1. Go to my.amplify.com and log in using the username and password your teacher provided.



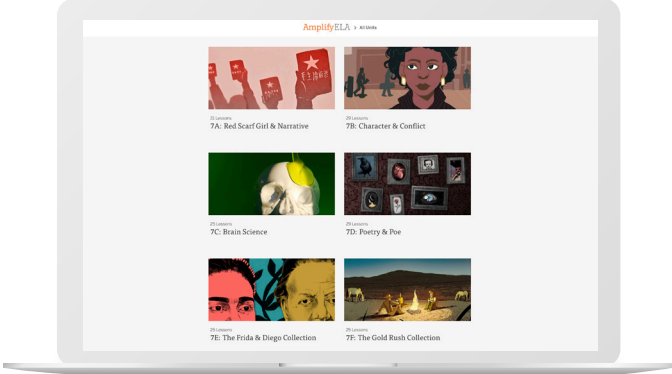

Program structure

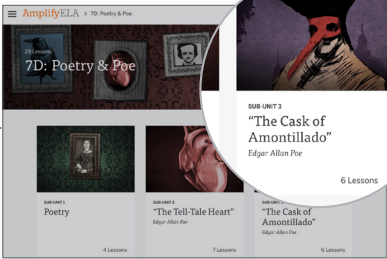
Before you jump in, take a quick look at the program structure to make sure you see how the navigation works.

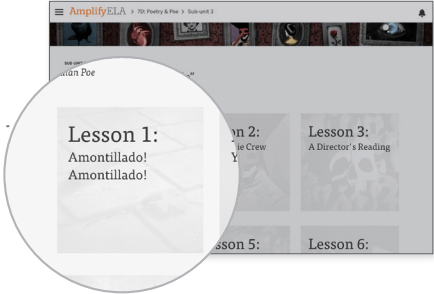

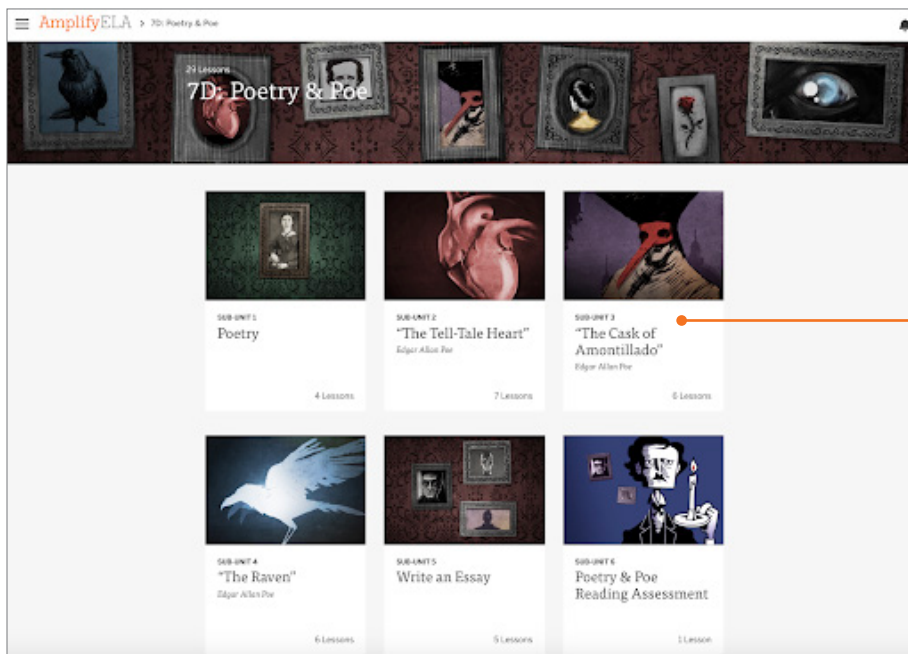
Exploring a unit

The work for your grade is divided into six units. The units are centered on literary or informational texts, delivered in several forms of media. You may also take on a longer assignment called a Quest where you work with your classmates to solve a mystery or explore a topic in depth.

Here's how to move around a unit:

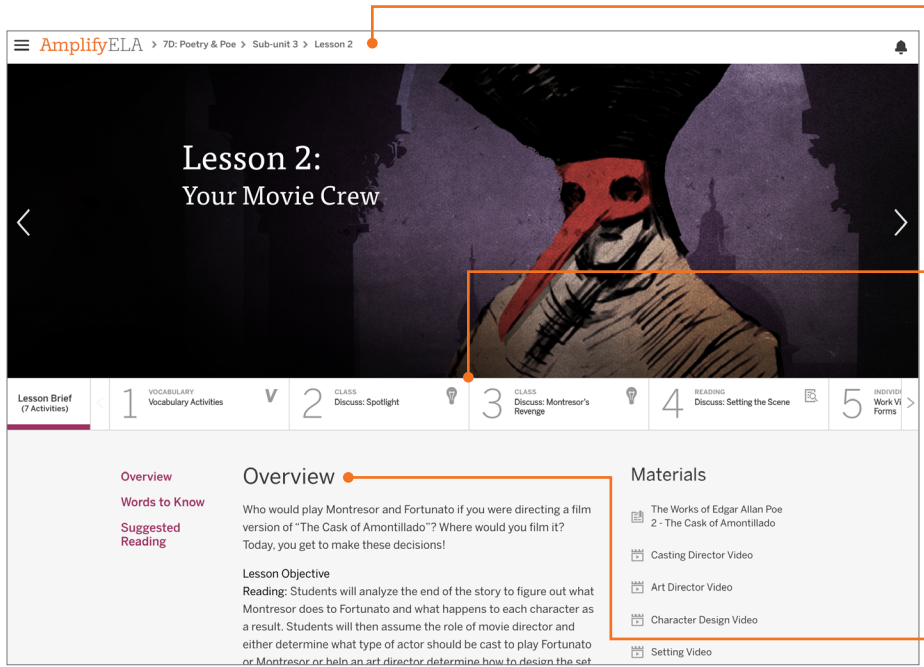


From the top nav bar, select your grade level. Then select your unit.



Once you've selected your unit, choose your sub-unit.

Exploring a lesson



You can always go back by following the navigation trail in the upper left corner.

The lesson map displays the sequence and type of activities in each lesson.

The arrow at the end of the lesson map alerts you that there are more activities in a lesson than what is shown. Click on the arrow to see additional activities.

The lesson brief provides valuable information to support you, including an overview of the text, key words to know, and other suggested reading. Click each menu item to expand the section for more information.

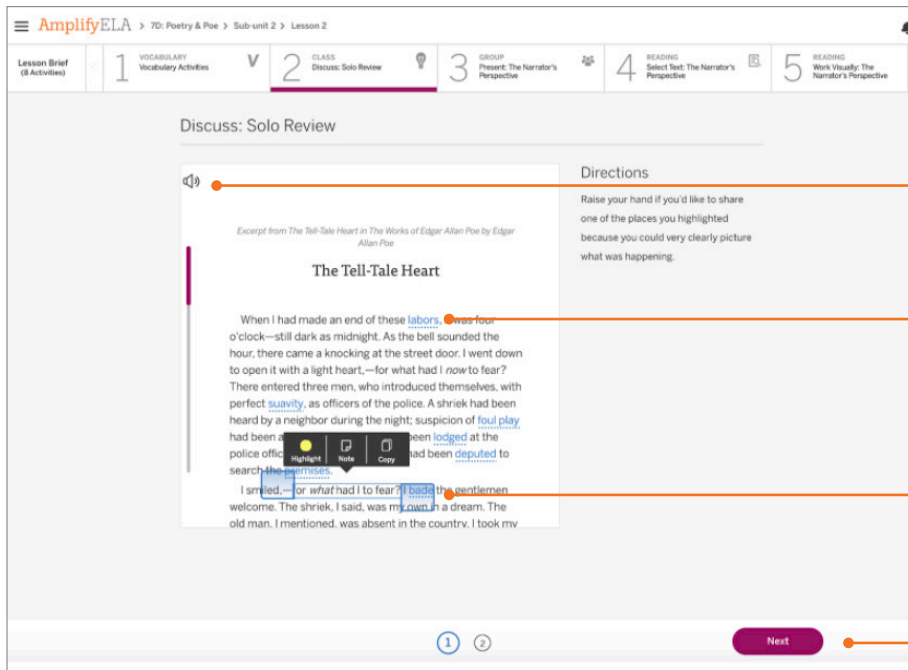

Click the speaker icon to have the text read to you if you're getting stuck reading it on your own.

Get the definition of difficult words by clicking on the *Reveal* words (the words in blue).

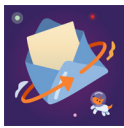
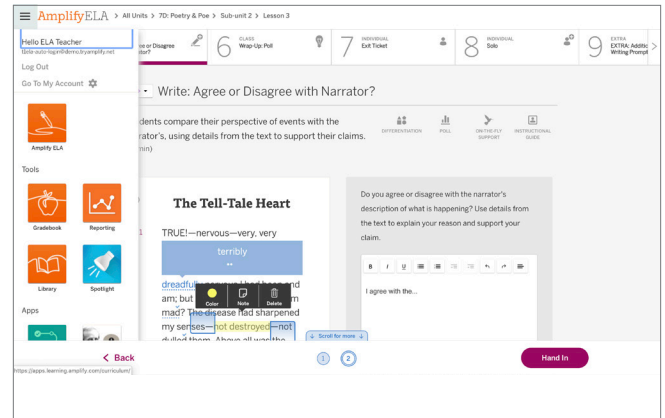
Highlight words and take notes by clicking and dragging your cursor.

You can find the Global Navigation menu in the top left corner of your screen. This menu includes many components and apps you'll want to use.

Vocab App

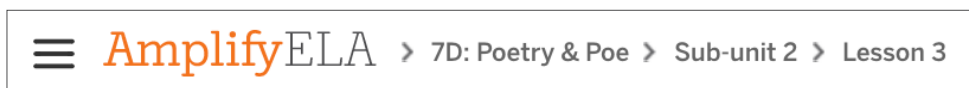
Vocabulary app: Provides engaging games, repeated encounters with new words across multiple contexts, and an interactive stats page that helps them track their own progress.
